


## A Note from our Pastor, Rev. Bill Russell

I am happy to report that with the 110 items of medication presented to the Clinic, \$100 donated to the Clinic by the DWM, Central generated a commitment of over 500 items of medicine or medical supplies to the Compassion Clinic. If you missed the opportunity to donate, you can still do so. The asking pledge is \$1 or one item of medication per month for 15 months. A fee to be collected from those sitting in the first 3 rows of pews at the front of the Sanctuary of \$1 per person. All other rows would be \$5 per person.

And the Chairman of the Board suggested that we take the Church credit card to our next Board Meeting which would be convened at a Tunica Casino.

But the consensus of opinion of the best suggestion was to have the congregation stand and get the purse or wallet of the person closest to them and then give like you always wanted to give."
