


A Note from our Pastor, Rev. Bill Russell




UPDATE ON CHURCH FACILITIES

It has been said more than once that we at Central Christian Church have a beautiful place to worship and to fellowship in. Of course to keep it that way requires that we be good stewards of what God has given to us so that we can worship, study, meet, and fellowship together.

While the church has been closed, repairs and maintenance continue. The City of Memphis graciously repaired the sidewalk on the southwest corner of Peabody and McLean. City workers had to tear up the corner when laying new pipes under the street. The electrical boxes on the second and third floors of the Education Building have been replaced. No longer do we have the old fuse boxes, which have been a fire hazard for many a year. This additionally helps Christ City Church with their electrical issues: there's no longer a need to replace blown fuses.

Unfortunately we have a significant problem with the gym roof. Over the years the roof has slowly deteriorated to the point there are water leaks on the gym floor. The leaks are dark brown and are slowly staining the floor. In addition to the gym floor, the third floor area in the southwest corner has water leaks that are seeping down to the showers on the second floor. The good news is that the Property and Ground Committee, along with the Executive Board and Trustees, are looking at ways to repair the roof. Hopefully we *all* will be good stewards and do what we can to solve this problem.




On the left is the lovely magnolia and on the right is the new Japanese red-leaf maple.
