Bob's daily prayer for Kenya began to bear fruit when he met a woman at a dinner party who ran the largest orphanage in Kenya. At her invitation, Bob toured the orphanage and was appalled at the lack of basic health care. He began contacting pharmaceutical companies and persuaded them to donate their unsold drugs to the orphanage-over a million dollars worth. As a result, he

met the president of Kenya and encouraged him to release political prisons. The leader agreed, and released the prisoners-a result our state department had tried to achieve through diplomacy without success! Later, the Kenyan leader had Bob travel back to Kenya to pray with him concerning the reorganization of his government.

Our group took this challenge and agreed each of us would pray daily for our church. That was February 8th, so by August 9th we'll expect great results.

In the meantime, we encourage you to join this effort and pray daily for our church.
