December Board Meeting

A General Board Meeting was held on December 17, 2015 and was Called to Order by the outgoing chairman Mark Rutledge who led the meeting in prayer.

The Minutes from the November 15, 2015 Meeting were approved as written.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: The Treasurer, John Bennett, presented the report which disclosed total income for November of \$16,005 and expenses that month of \$16,679. He also gave year to date figures of income at \$107,437 and expenses of \$114,517, resulting in a shortfall for the year to date of \$7080. The Treasurer also commented on additional security measures that were being taken following a theft of property and attempted theft of Church funds in October.

A number of other matters were discussed including a proposal amending the list of Board Officers to be presented to the congregation for approval.

<u>Appreciation for Board Leadership:</u> John Johnson extended appreciation on behalf of the Board to Mark Rutledge for his leadership and love and dedication to the church. It was a unanimous proclamation of appreciation.

Adjournment: The meeting adjourned at 8:25 PM, and Kathy Young led the closing prayer.

Installation of 2016 Board Officers

A congregational Meeting was held, after our Church service on Sunday 27th December, to approve the 2016 Budget and to approve the list of Officers for 2016. The list comprised of Chairman Elect Richard Brown, Treasurer George Goodnight, Financial Secretary John Bennett, and Board Secretary Connie Bennett. Both proposals were approved unanimously.

The Installation of the Board Officers was made during our service on January 3rd. Also during the service

the incoming Board Chairman Wesley Goodnight handed Mark Rutledge, the outgoing Chairman, an engraved plaque as a token of the appreciation of the congregation for Mark's outstanding contribution to our Church during his year in the Chair. After the service the DWM hosted a reception with the refreshments being prepared by Debra and George Goodnight.
