A Note from our Pastor, Rev. Bill Russell

On Ash Wednesday, we began our Lenten journey with a wonderful service with our brothers and sisters from Kingsway and St. Francis. I truly hope that each of you is, if not memorizing Psalm 51, at least reading it so that the words of David become your words during Lent. Friday evening, March 4, we have been invited by Deacon Frank Williams to join the congregation at Immaculate Conception for a service explaining in detail the stations of the cross. The service begins at 5:30 and will last approximately 30 minutes. Following the service we are invited to a fish fry there. After the fish fry, Deacon Frank has volunteered to give us a behind-the-scenes tour of the cathedral. I did this a couple of years ago, and it is fascinating as well as very educational. Wednesday evenings during Lent we are having a video series, GLORY DAYS, led by Max Lucado. It leads us into the spirit of Lent in an unorthodox way, but is very good. Maundy Thursday we will combine worship and a meal with Kingsway Christian Church, Lindenwood and St. Francis, at Kingsway. The meal will be served at 6:15 and the service will begin at 7. I really am excited about this service and I hope many of you will attend. We will have rides available from Central and more information will be coming about that. Good Friday services will be with Lindenwood at 5:30, and again, more information will be forthcoming. All of this culminates with Easter Sunday morning. The men will be serving breakfast at 9:00, Sunday School will be at 10:00, and then we will celebrate the joy of the resurrection at 10:45. This will be a glorious day and my prayer is that every member of Central will be there for worship. Immediately following worship we will pause long enough to take a new congregational picture, so add that 15 minutes into your Easter schedule. Lent, Holy Week, and Easter are very special times; I hope that we all will all take advantage of the different opportunities to worship and draw nearer to our Lord. I'll see you Sunday.

Several Sundays ago the word "expectation" was said several times during one of our worship services. For some reason this word has been buzzing around in my head and just won't go away.

On Sunday morning each one of us expects to come to Central to meet and great our church family, to gather in the sanctuary to worship our God, to fellowship, and to remember our Savior, Jesus Christ. We expect to be warm in the winter and to be cool during those hot summer months. We take for granted (or expect) to have the lights on to help us see, plumbing that works, and a phone and the internet that we can communicate with our church family.


Special Called Regional Assembly
