



As we left our Ash Wednesday service, I commented that the cross which was placed on your forehead would be gone in a very short while, and I asked, "How will folks know we are Christians once the crosses are gone?" The answer was in our closing hymn which ended, "Yes, they'll know that we are Christians by our love." As they observe Lent, many people give up things that they enjoy, they sacrifice their pleasures. Others look to do good things that they don't normally do. I think that familiar hymn could direct us, as we seek to deepen the spirit of our Lenten season, to simply try to show more love to those around us. Lent is about our journey to the cross and the empty tomb, the ultimate statement of God's love. As we focus on God's love for us, I hope we realize the responsibility and privilege we have to share that love with all those around us. There's a world out there that needs to know of His love.

Wesley Goodnight - Chicken Chile


Carol Scarberry - Potato Soup


