
In-person Worship - At last!

It's official: Central Christian Church will be opening its doors once again for in-person worship on Palm Sunday, March 28th at 9:00 a.m. After one year of staying at home and viewing worship services on-line, church members, friends, and visitors will once again greet and say hello to one another.

However, as the old saying goes: "We're not out of the woods yet!" Because of the COVID-19 virus, everyone still has to take precautions. This includes wearing a mask to church and doing one's best at social distancing. Hand sanitizer is a must, so there will be plenty of opportunity to use it as you enter and leave the church.

worship, everyone is asked to follow the following guidelines to keep everyone safe as possible:

- Wear a mask one will be provided if you need one;
- Please sit where "X marks the spot" (See photos on the right);
- Select your communion elements before you enter the Sanctuary (See photos below);
- Place all tithes and offerings in the brass plate as you enter or leave the Sanctuary.

The above guidelines are just the beginning. As we continue to meet for worship for the next several months, adjustments will probably be needed. So, *BE PATIENT*!

On the back page of this edition of the *Banner* is a diagram of the seats that are marked for sitting at social distancing. Everyone is asked to sit where's an "X". In the case of families sitting together, adjustments are allowed.

When the worship service has ended, everyone is asked to leave the Sanctuary as quickly as possible. Christ City Church will need time to set up for their Facebook Live.







The three pictures of the Sanctuary pews show "X where marks the spot". These specific locations have been designated for "social distancing". Please note that Christ City Church helped to prepare the pews for Central Christian as well as Christ City.

TAKING COMMUNION - THE NEW WAY-

In order to have a safe environment as we worship, prepared communion will be available as you enter through the Narthex. Please select your elements and have them ready when we partake communion in unison. Please note that if you select element #2, open the bread side first, then the liquid side.



- Place communion elements on display in the Narthex prior to worship service;
- Remove communion elements after worship service;
- Pick up and dispose of all empty communion elements.

In order to become familiar with the above tasks, Deacons are asked to arrive a few minutes early before the Palm Sunday service to go over and become familiar with our new way of worshiping.

Please note that Deacons will not have to take up the offering nor distribute communion until it is once again safe to do so.


SOCIAL DISTANCE SEATING
