

Message From Pastor Bill Russell





STOP HUNGER NOW


Volunteers Needed

There is a lot of work to be done And, yes I know May the 5th 2023 looks months away, but a majority of the work has to be completed by the end of October. Why? The reason is that November. December, and most of January are full of holiday events - and no one really wants to work on a committee during that time.



Many of our readers may not know that the sound mixer located at the back of the Sanctuary is G.B.N.F. (Gone, But Not Forgotten). Several weeks ago the unit stopped working and Sound Lab was called in to help resolve the prob-

lem. The sad news is that the sound Sound Mixer mixer no longer works and cannot be repaired. This leaves Central Christian without a sound system in the Sanctuary. However, the Chairman of Property and Grounds is working on a solution. The staff at the *Banner* will keep you informed.
